Price collection is one of the important tasks being attended by the Directorate of Economics & Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of controlling prices to avoid exploitation of adverse conditions.



1.RICE (OPEN MARKET)

Comparison of State average retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month of Feb.2015 a marginal decrease was noticed in the State average retail prices of items in the group when compared with the prices of the previous month Jan.2015. The prices of Rice superfine and fine slightly decreased by 0.69 % and 0.86% when compared with the previous month Jan.2015. When compared with the corresponding month of the previous year, State average retail prices of Rice common variety has increased by 6.27% where as the price of Fine Variety and Super Fine variety marginally decreased by 1.05% and 2.07%. 
Comparison of State average retail Prices of Cereals

During the month of Feb.2015, a slight decrease was noticed in the state average retail prices of Wheat (0.03%), Jowar (0.40) ,Ragulu(0. 40%) and Bajra (0.34%) when compared with the last month, Jan.2015.

When compared with the corresponding month of previous year (Jan. 2014), the Stage Average Retail Prices of Wheat and Jowar were increased by 3.15% and 10.99% respectively, while other items viz. Ragulu and Bajra shown downward trend of 1.18% and 0.77%. The prices and percentage variation over the previous month and year of selected cereals are presented in the following table and diagram.


3.Pulses

Comparison of State average retail Prices of Pulses

During the month of Feb.2015, an upward trend is observed in the prices of Redgram dal (2.93%) Bengal gram dal (3.38%) and Blackgram dal (0.19%) and downward trend is observe red in Moong dal (0.29%) when compared with the prices of previous month.

When compared with the corresponding month of the previous year state average retail prices of Redgram dal, Bengalgram dal, Moong dal and Blackgram dal are shown an upward trend and increased by 20.49%,7.08%,19.39% and 30.19 % respectively. 
4.Edible Oils & Fats

Comparison of State average retail Prices of Edible Oils & Fats

During the month of Feb.2015, the prices of all varieties of Edible Oils is shown slight increasing trend except palm oil and Vanaspathi when compared with the prices of previous month.

When compared with the corresponding month of previous year, the state average retail prices of Sunflower oil, Palm oil and Vanaspathi are shown downtrend and decreased by 4.26%, 9.23% and 0.94% respectively, whereas the Ground nut oil has increased by 7.09.


5. Condiments & Spices

Comparison of state average retail prices of selected Condiments and Spices

An upward trend is observed in the state average retail prices of selected condiments & spices. During the month of Feb.2015, slight increase is observed in the prices of Turmeric Powder, Red Chillies (Gr-II) and Tamarind by 0.12% ,0.80%, 0.75% respectively when compared with the prices of previous month.

The prices of all items are shown upward trend and increased from 5% to 67% when compared with the price of corresponding month of previous year. The prices and percentage of variation over the previous month and year of selected condiments & spices are shown in the following table and diagram.


Comparison of state average retail prices of vegetables

The prices of potatoes, Brinjals and Lady's Finger and Tomatoes are shown upward trend and increased by 12.82%,22.46%,21.64% and 65.69% respectively when compared with the price of corresponding month of previous year.


Comparison of State average retail prices of other food items

II. Consumer Price Index Numbers

The main objective of Consumer Price Index is to measure changes over a period of time in the level of retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services consumed by a targeted group of people.

There are different consumer price indices compiled by different organizations for different segments of consumers namely, Industrial workers (IW), Agricultural Labourers (AL) and Rural Labourers (RL), CPI for Rural Population, Urban Population and combined.

1. Consumer Price Index Numbers for Industrial workers

Labour Bureau has been compiling and releasing CPI Numbers for Industrial Workers with base year 2001 on the last working day of the following month for each of the selected 78 centres at All India level. The following 3 centers are covered in Andhra Pradesh. 1. **Guntur 2. Visakhapatnam 3. Vijayawada**

On par with Central series, the Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Govt. of A.P is also compiling the CPI (IW) with the same base year 2001 for the following Complex centres as State Series.




GENERAL INFLATION:-

The inflation based on CPI-IW (general) for the month of Jan.2015 stood at 7.17 % as compared to 5.86 % for Dec.2014 and 7.24% during the corresponding month of the previous year.



FOOD INFLATION

➤ Inflation based on Food Index stood at **7.81** % in **Jan.2015** as against **5.73**% in **Dec.2014** and **8.94** % during the corresponding month of the previous year.



Consumer Price Index for Agricultural Labourers/Rural Labourers:

Labour Bureau has been compiling CPI Numbers for Agricultural Labourers since September, 1964. The existing series of CPI Numbers for (i) Agricultural Labourers and (ii) Rural Labourers (base 1986-87=100) replaced the earlier series on base 1960-61=100 w.e.f. November, 1995. For compilation of these index numbers, the Field Operations Division (FOD) of the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) collects prices data from 600 selected sample villages in 20 States. In Andhra Pradesh 54 Villages are covered.

The All–India Consumer price Index Numbers for Agricultural Labourers and Rural labourers for **January.2015** decreased by 3 and 2 points to stand at **804** points and **808** points respectively. (Base: 1986-87=100)

USAGE:-

The minimum basic rates of wages fixed are linked to the Consumer Price Index Numbers for the Agricultural workers. The Commissioner of Labour notified the Cost of Living Allowance for every six months on 1st April and 1st October of the calendar year.

For this purpose, the average arise in the State Agricultural workers Consumer Price Index numbers for the half year ending with December and June respectively shall be taken into account.`

GENERAL INFLATION: The point to point rate of inflation based on

- > CPI-AL increased from 5.49 % in **Dec. 2014** to **6.21** % in **Jan.2015**
- CPI-RL increased from 5.74 % in Dec. 2014 to 6.46 % in Jan.2015.


FOOD INFLATION

Inflation based on Food Index of CPI-AL and CPI-RL are 5.29 % and **5.55**% respectively during **Jan.2015**.

3. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX NUMBERS FOR RURAL, URBAN AND COMBINED (Base 2012=100)

The Central Statistics Office (CSO) introduced a new series of overall Consumer Price Indices for rural, urban and combined and revised its baseyear from 2010=100 to 2012=100 for All India and States/Union Territories from January 2015. These new indices are compiled at State/UT and all-India levels.


4. WHOLESALE PRICE INDEX (WPI)

Wholesale Price Index is compiled and released by the Office of the Economic Advisor, Ministry of Commerce and Industry on monthly basis. The WPI measures the average change over a period of time in the selling prices of producer's goods. The concept of wholesale price adopted in practice represent the quoted price of bulk transaction generally at primary stage, the price pertaining to bulk transaction of agricultural commodities(farm harvest prices/prices at the village mandi/Market)and ex-factory prices for others. The base year for WPI is 2004-05. A total of 676 items are included in the WPI covering 5482 quotations.

The Wholesale Price Index for 'All Commodities' (Base: 2004-05=100) for the month of Jan-2015 declined by 0.8 % to 178.3 (Provisional) from 179.8 (Provisional) for the previous month.


GENERAL INFLATION:

The annual rate of inflation, based on monthly WPI, stood at -0.39% (Provisional) for the month of January-2015 (over January-2014) as compared to 0.11 % (Provisional) for the previous month and 5.11 % during the corresponding month of previous year.



FOOD INFLATION:

Inflation based on Food index is increased to 8.00% in **January-2015** from 5.20% in Dec'14.



FINAL INDEX FOR THE MONTH OF November. 2014: (Base: 2004-05=100)

For the month of Nov.2014, the final Wholesale Price Index for "All Commodities" (Base : 2004-05=100) stood at 181.2 as compared to 181.5

(provisional) and annual rate of inflation based on final index stood at 0.17% as compared to 0.00% respectively as reported on 14.11.2014.

7. WHOLESALE PRICES OF 40 AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES:

The wholesale prices of 40 agricultural commodities are collected and compiled on monthly basis (last Friday of the month) with District as a unit and State average wholesale Price report is prepared. These prices are used to assess the price trends at wholesale centers. In addition to utilizing the same prices for verification of the market trend, they are also used for comparison with farm harvest prices and retail prices.
